STOP SIGN ORDINANCE

The Board of Selectmen for the Town of Monkton hereby adopts this ordinance as follows:

1. Enactment. This ordinance is enacted pursuant to 24 V.S.A. Chapter 59 and 23 V.S.A. Section 1008.
2. Requirement. When "Stop" signs are erected at or near the entrance to any intersection, every driver or operator of a motor vehicle approaching a stop sign shall bring the vehicle to a complete stop at or near the intersection of the street, but not more than 10 feet therefrom.
3. Designation. The following are hereby designated as stop streets and stop signs are hereby authorized for said locations:

Lime Kiln Rd. at Monkton Rd.

Parks - Hurlburt Rd. at Monkton Rd.

Old Stage Rd. at Parks - Hurlburt Rd.

Piney Woods Rd. at Parks - Hurlburt Rd.

Piney Woods Rd. at Barnum Rd.

Barnum Rd. at Hardscrabble Rd.

Piney Woods Rd. and Boro Hill Rd. at Hardscrabble Rd. -
4 way stop

Hardscrabble Rd. at Bristol Rd.

Church Rd. at Bristol Rd.

Mountain Rd. at States Prison Hollow Rd.

Tyler Bridge Rd. at States Prison Hollow Rd.

Davis Rd. at Monkton Ridge

Bristol Rd. and Monkton Rd. at Monkton Ridge - 3 way stop

Library Way at States Prison Hollow Rd.

Pond Rd. at Rotax Rd.

Covered Bridge Rd. at Rotax Rd. - 2 way stop

Higbee Rd. at Hollow Rd.

Hand Rd. at Hollow Rd.

Bennett Rd. at Hollow Rd.

Hollow Rd. and Boro Hill Rd. at Monkton Rd. and Monkton
Rd. North and South - 4 way stop

Mountain Rd. At Bristol Rd.

4. Effective Date. This ordinance is hereby adopted on January 12, 2009 and shall become effective 60 days from this date.
5. Repeal. Upon the date this ordinance becomes effective, it shall repeal any prior stop sign ordinance established in the Town which is inconsistent herewith.
6. Enforcement. Violation of any provision of this ordinance or regulation promulgated thereunder shall be deemed a traffic violation pursuant to 23 V.S.A. Sections 2201- 2207, as presently enacted or as from time to time hereinafter amended. Any such violation constituting a traffic offense shall be prosecuted pursuant to 23 V.S.A. Sections 2201 - 2207, and any such violator will be subject to the procedures, provisions and penalties as outlined therein, and shall be considered a violation of Vermont State Statute for purposes of 13 V.S.A. Section 7251 as presently enacted or as from time to time hereinafter amended.

NOTICE OF ORDINANCE ADOPTION AND OF RIGHT TO PETITION

Notice is hereby given by the Town of Monkton Selectboard of the adoption on January 12, 2009 of ordinance for the location and compliance with stop signs on highways in the Town of Monkton.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This ordinance is adopted to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Monkton.

PRINCIPAL PROVISIONS: The ordinance designates Town highway intersections at which stop signs shall be located, establishes requirements for drivers and operators of motor vehicles when approaching a stop sign in the Town of Monkton and provides for enforcement of the ordinance.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION: 24 V.S.A. § 1973 provides that not less than five percent (5%) of the qualified voters of the municipality may petition for a vote on the question of disapproving an ordinance if presented to the Board of Selectman or the Town Clerk within forty-four (44) days (before February 25, 2009) following the date of adoption of the ordinance by the Board of Selectman. Reference is made to § 1973 for more particulars concerning this right to petition. If no petition is filed within this time period, the ordinance will become effective on March 13, 2009.
