3. John and Linda Phillips Review of a First Cut Application 2014-06-FC

John Phillips reviewed his first cut project. They have done the septic work and are awaiting the permit. The property is located in both the 2 and 5-acre zones. The house site is planned in the 5-acre zone. Mr. Phillips thinks there are 2 acres in the 2-acre zone.

The Board ran the checklist. The project was missing addresses of abutting landowners; he will bring these at the time of the hearing. The Board needs information on the amount of land in the 2-acre zone.

4. David Fost Review of a Proposed Variance for an Accessory Building

David Fost reviewed his request for a variance on Mountain Road. He has a 1-acre lot and wants to build an accessory building. The variance would require 25 feet on the northeast side and 10 feet on the north side of the property. A current application was not filled out. Mr. Fost will complete the application for the Board.

Old Business

5. Porter/Goldstein Review of the Preliminary Application 2014-04-MAJ

The Board reviewed the project application for a subdivision that creates 3 lots.

The Board ran the checklist. The application had some older project materials mixed in.

Curtis Layn made the motion to set the project for a preliminary hearing on April 22^{nd} at 8:35pm, and Philip Russell seconded the motion. The vote passed: 5-0-0 with the Chair voting.

6. 8:35pm Peter Norris Sketch Plan Hearing 2014-05-MAJ

The applicant did not show.

7. Kevin Williams, KDW, Review of the Preliminary Application 2014-03-MAJ

The Board reviewed the project application for a subdivision.

The Board discussed issues when a project reopens a subdivision and creates new lots.

The project only had one copy of the narrative. The Board ran the checklist. The applicant has applied for a driveway cut, but has not received it. The project has been warned for March 25th at 8pm. Thea Gaudette will contact the applicant to remind them to resend the warning to abutters with the hearing information.

Thea Gaudette made the motion that the application is complete and ready for the project for a preliminary hearing on March 25th at 8:00pm, and Curtis Layn seconded the motion. The vote passed: 5-0-0 with the Chair voting.

8. Andrew Petersen's Malt House Project 2013-07-CU

Ken Wheeling provided a copy of the property map from the vault; it was added to the file. The Board reviewed the letter sent to the applicant describing why the project was incomplete.
