<u>ARTICLE</u> 8: Shall the voters approve a sum not to exceed \$80,000.00 for the purchase of a Ford 550 truck for the Highway Department. (YEA)

<u>ARTICLE</u> 9: Shall the voters approve a sum not to exceed \$78,000.00 for the addition to the Monkton Volunteer Fire Department Fire Station. (YEA)

<u>ARTICLE</u> 10: Shall the Town of Monkton adopt its budget article or articles by Australian ballot? (NAY)

<u>ARTICLE</u> 11: Shall the Town of Monkton vote on all public questions by Australian ballot? (NAY)

<u>ARTICLE</u> 12: Shall the voters of the Town of Monkton vote to advise the Selectboard to use the Town land adjacent to the Monkton Friends Methodist Church for its originally intended purpose as a site of a new Town Hall only and not for a Municipal Park and Ride Lot? (YEA) Hand vote 72 Aye, 30 Nay.

<u>ARTICLE</u> 13: Shall the voters authorize the Select Board to borrow money from time to time and pledge the credit of the Town from the past and present indebtedness as may be necessary for them. (YEA)

**ARTICLE** 14: To transact any other business proper to come before this meeting.
