As there was no quorum only the business of receiving an update by Will Aldridge, Eagle Scout Candidate on Town Signs Project was conducted.

1) Will Aldridge, Update on Town Signs Project

Will indicated he had contacted a number of sign companies to obtain quotes and the prices ranged from \$95 per sign (\$380 for four) from South Burlington sign, Kershner Signs (Aluminite) \$1330 for four signs and Signarama \$1122 for four signs. These signs are 36" by 30 ".

We discussed the mounting posts and cross members plus fasteners and Will is to approach local merchants to see if he can solicited donations.

We suggested that he next contact Wayne Preston Road Commissioner to get his input and advice as to location and roadside positioning and then to approach the affected landowners where the signs are to be located to ensure there is no objection.

Will should also consider manpower or machine requirements for setting the signs up.

We suggested he get back to us in May with an update and a fuller handle on costs and go ahead from Wayne and landowners. Once we have all this in hand we can take it to the select board.
