2. Stephen Pilcher, Monkton Select Board chair, spoke to the commission about the need for the Town to begin searching for a zoning administrator. Strategies were discussed.
Mr. Pilcher also spoke about having the Select Board, the Planning Commission, and the Development Review Board set up a meeting with a representative of VLCT to help these boards more clearly define their duties.
3. W.S. Harper and M. Cargill were happy to announce that a municipal planning grant application for the sum of \$9677.00 had been submitted to help assist the MPC with their update of the town plan. Many thanks to them.
4. Discussion about what information we need to obtain to address the issue of solar installation siting in the Town Plan.
