Stewardship

- Reviewed draft of the Pond Brook Management Plan
 - o Made a few edits during discussion.
 - Next step is to consult with the Vermont Land Trust (who owns the conservation easement) on the draft and how to monitor this area in accord with the plan.
 - O Discussed gathering public input? Perhaps posting the draft for comment and inviting the public to one of our meetings to discuss it.

Working with Other Committees

- Maps for committees and residents to use (such as the Development Review Board)
 - o Reviewed possible map layers (such as wetlands or forest blocks)
 - o Consolidated the list somewhat, matching up related layers
 - O Next meeting: will continue to work on this between meetings (Jaime and Caroline). Some proof-of-concept views will be created for different maps, to see what we want to move forward with.

Community Engagement

- Values Mapping
 - o Reviewed Elevator Pitch & Plan next steps.
 - O Will get help from the Scouts in spreading the word about the Values Mapping event (Travis Guillemette and George Parker). Reviewed the list of stakeholders to reach out to.
 - o For next time:
 - Finalize outreach materials, consider a tentative date in the fall.
 - Identify a few stakeholders each of us will reach out to as a date comes into focus (post covid-19)

New Business

- COVID-19 Response
 - O Discussed that community engagement on conservation topics would be good, such as:
 - Local mushrooms, tree/plant ID, ramps, fiddleheads, etc.
 - Managing invasive species education, community action days (with plenty of distancing) working on our own properties or in very small numbers at sites like Morse Park.
 - How to use iNaturalist.
 - O We will make some posts along these lines on Front Porch Forum and the Monkton Facebook group.

Updates & Other Items

- Agency of Natural Resources frequently approves water bottling permits. This could be a concern for Monkton. Water resources/aquifers are not mapped and yet extraction of water is approved? We'll look at this further and perhaps contact legislators and other Conservation Commissions.
- Lewis Creek Watershed Invasives received a letter from the Hinesburg Conservation Commission. The Lewis Creek Association will be doing a survey of aquatic invasive species in Monkton Pond and Bristol Pond. We'll obtain approval to share with the town so those interested can be involved.
- Printing of the wildlife guide postponed.
- Current Use Brochure postponed.
- Mark Boltz-Robinson, Monkton Tree Warden, may join us at our next meeting to talk about Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) awareness and monitoring, now that EABs are presumed to be in Monkton already after being confirmed in neighboring towns.
- Travis Guillemette joined us for today's meeting as part of earning his Citizenship in the Community merit badge. Thanks for participating, Travis!
