In the last 10 years, Monkton's Agricultural and Natural Areas Fund has leveraged \$345,800 of town funds into \$4,113,025 of project funding for 9 projects that have conserved 1635 acres (2.55 square miles!) of farmland, forestland and wetlands, and facilitated the transfer of 179 acres to the next generation.

*Option to Purchase at Agricultral Value - this easement (the first in Monkton!) predated the option for the next owner to purchase the conserved ag land at agricultural value (minus the development potential), so this easement was updated to help transfer The Last Resort Farm to the next generation. All other ag easements in Monkton have the OPAV included in current easement language.
