Town of Monkton Development Review Board DRAFT MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, May 11th, 2021 7:30pm

Regular Meeting in-person at the Fire Station

Board Members Present: Betsy Brown (Chair), Curtis Layn, Jaime Schulte, Phil Russell

B. Brown called the meeting to order at 7:37pm.

Reviewed the Sketch Plan Application of Miranda Fisk to amend a previously approved Planned Unit Development (PUD) at 315 Roscoe Road. The amendment consists of subdividing Lot 5 into 2 lots and reconfiguring the location of the 20% Set Aside land.

Wetlands have been delineated to the west of the cemetery and will have a 50' buffer. Originally the PUD had an L-shaped Set Aside area in the northwest corner of the project, but M. Fisk would like to change that to be an east/west corridor across the north end of the PUD. She mentioned that this change improves forest and wetland connectivity across the center of a larger ring of forested land around the PUD (includes Raven's Ridge, etc). J. Schulte agreed that east/west forest connectivity is sometimes lacking in Monkton because of our north/south topography, with development and agriculture in the north/south valleys.

There might not be enough land between the north side of the cemetery and the wetland buffer for a building envelope, so that could be placed south of the cemetery (with cemetery access for the public preserved).

- B. Brown noted there is something shown on the Important Resource Areas and Wildlife Habitat map in the UPD in the southeast corner of the overall parcel, near the stream/wetland and access road to the cemetery. Similar question came up about a recent project and we can find out what that item is from Vermont Fish & Wildlife. J. Schulte to provide contacts at F&W for Miranda Fisk to follow-up.
- J. Schulte moved to approve the Sketch Plan Application of Miranda Fisk to amend a previously approved Planned Unit Development at 315 Roscoe Road. C. Layn seconded. No additional discussion. All were in favor (4-0-0).
- C. Layn needed to depart the meeting at 8:02pm, immediately following the Sketch Plan review, bringing the meeting below quorum.
- P. Russell moved to adjourn. J. Schulte seconded. All were in favor (4-0-0). Meeting adjourned at 8:02pm.
