Mission Statement/Goals

At the 2006 Town Meeting the voters of Monkton authorized the purchase of approximately five acres on Monkton Ridge for \$92,000. At the most recent Town Meeting the voters authorized the creation of a Municipal Building Fund and funded it with \$40,000. The Municipal Building Committee sets as its mission and goals the following:

- 1. Determine the needs and requirements for a new Town Hall.
- 2. Determine the needs and requirements for a new Town Library.
- 3. Determine the needs and requirements for a community center.
- 4. In the event a new building is proposed, determine what the possible uses of the old building are and make concrete recommendations.
- 5. Create cost estimates and timelines for any building project.
- 6. Volunteers organize volunteers who can reduce costs in the form of free labor, materials or donations.
- 7. Grants work with the Selectboard and other members of the community to identify pre and post production grants.
- 8. Generate community support for any proposed project.
- 9. Prepare informational materials and distribute.
