Introduction

This listing of Monkton soldiers who served in the American Civil War has three sections. The first section lists all the soldiers who are included in the “Roster of Vermonters” as residents of Monkton at the time of service. The second section lists those soldiers who served from other locations at the time of service but are buried in Monkton cemeteries. The third section lists soldiers born in Monkton who were residents of other towns and states at the time of service. This third listing is very small and reflects the discovery of this information during other research on Monkton Civil War soldiers. Names are alphabetical by regiment and company. A complete alphabetical index is included.
