### WORK OBSERVED:

#### Rotax Road:

- No Personnel on site. There was a MDB drill rig at the edge of the road in the LOD. It appears that they will begin probing in the area between stations 1286+00 – 1292+00 tomorrow.

#### Monkton Road:

- Michels Boring Crew is boring under Monkton Road. All boring equipment is set up in the LOD on the north side of the road. A water tanker was making a delivery while GME was on site. The tanker had to park in the road, and one lane traffic was maintained through the site.
- Michels was welding to the south of Monkton Road, (station ±1500+00) where they will be pulling the drill pipe from.

#### Old Stage Road:

- MDB was not on site in the area due to protesting. An individual had climbed a tree around station 1554+00 and tied off to MDB's drill rig. Law enforcement was working to clear the area so that MDB could resume work tomorrow.
- A JAM crew was cleaning up the area that was blasted earlier in the week around station 1519+00. They were planning to move blast mats, but could not because of the protesting activities.
