

# PUBLIC NOTICE: FUTURE ROAD WORK

This notice is from the Monkton Highway Department to inform you that our crew will be conducting work on your road on the following dates:

May 18<sup>th</sup>\* to June 19<sup>th</sup>\*

The crew will be ditching several sections of the road, removing and cutting trees and installing several culverts to improve drainage, reduce washouts/runoff, erosion, and potholes in accordance with state guidelines outlined in the VTRANS Better Roads manual.

The highway department will be conducting all work as directed by the Monkton Selectboard within the town's right of way (ROW) in accordance with 19 V.S.A. § 304, which grants the town broad authority to lay out, construct, maintain, and alter town highways and bridges, within the right-of-way (ROW).

The ROW (ROW) for a Class 3 dirt road is three rods (49.5ft) wide.

# **Town of Monkton – Highway Department Hardscrabble Road Work Project – 2026**

Planned work zone: Approximately 1226 Hardscrabble Rd, Monkton, VT to 2360 Hardscrabble Rd, Monkton, VT.

Work to be performed:

- Tree and stump removal
- Brush clearing
- Ditching and erosion control
- Culvert replacements and additions
- Roadway rebuilding (using the full 25-foot right-of-way as needed)

Schedule and duration:

- Minimum 30 working days

Equipment on site:

- John Deere 75G excavator
- Tandem-axle dump truck(s)
- John Deere 672P motor grader
- John Deere 524K loader
- GMC Sierra
- Ford F550
- Brush Chipper
- Full sign package (Road Work, Be Prepared to Stop, Flagger signs)

Traffic and safety:

- Flaggers may be present at times.
- Please “Slow Down and Move Over” when possible. Do not pass if you are unsure what’s ahead of the work zone.
- Expect delays and plan accordingly.

This project is the initial phase to conduct needed improvements and corrections to the road so it could be paved in the future pending voter approval of funds.
